FACULTY SPEAKER

Sharon Friedman's teaching and research interests are in the areas of literary and dramatic criticism, feminist criticism, theories of adaptation, and critical writing across the curriculum. Her courses have included "Literary Forms and the Craft of Criticism," "Revisioning the Classics," "Text and Performance" (which she co-taught with Julie Malnig), "Fictionalizing History/Historicizing Fiction," and "The Art of the Personal Essay." She is editor of the volume *Feminist Theatrical Revisions of Classic Works* (McFarland, 2009) and co-author (with Cheryl Black) of *Modern American Drama: Playwriting in the 1990s* (Bloomsbury Methuen Drama, 2018), and her essays have appeared in numerous journals and volumes. Her current book project addresses gendered violence in the theatre of war. She was the recipient of an NYU Distinguished Teaching Award, which recognizes that one of NYU's primary institutional priorities, along with research, is exceptional teaching inside and outside the classroom setting.

ABOUT GALLATIN

The Gallatin School of Individualized Study is named after Albert Gallatin, one of the founders of NYU, who served as the Secretary of the Treasury under Presidents Jefferson and Madison. Gallatin believed that New York City needed a college that would serve its varied urban population and which would “elevate the standard of learning and . . . render knowledge more accessible to the community at large.” Gallatin’s dream was realized in 1831 with the founding of New York University.

As in the preceding century, the demands of the late-20th century called for innovations in higher education. NYU’s response was the founding, in 1972, of an experimental program called University Without Walls (UWW), which became the Gallatin Division in 1976.

The success of the Division led to the establishment, in 1995, of the Gallatin School of Individualized Study.

For more than four decades, Gallatin has developed an educational approach that offers a unique combination of flexibility and rigor. The School attracts bright, self-directed, and highly motivated students who take initiative in designing their own educations. Gallatin students create unique projects and investigate different areas of knowledge across the disciplines and benefit from the teaching and mentoring of a distinguished faculty of scholars, advisers, and from the wealth of offerings available in one of the world’s great universities and urban centers.
